

Project Prom 2010 General Meeting
January 19, 2010

Meeting called to order at 7:07. 55 people in attendance. Meeting held at Langham Creek High School room 1903.

Welcome and introductions:

- Andrea Goodhart welcomed everyone and introduced the board members in attendance and reminded everyone to sign in at each meeting and also enter the door prize drawing for extra Lobo Bucks.

September general meeting minutes:

- Andrea proposed to accept the minutes from the last general meeting. Kirk Jennings motioned, Lynn Kennedy seconded, passed and minutes accepted.

Treasurer:

- Stacy Redmond reported: \$54,692.74 is our net balance as of today. A copy of the financials will be emailed to everyone. Mr. Lobo netted ~\$13,100.
- Please turn in any outstanding receipts for reimbursements and deposits as soon as possible.

Fundraisers:

- King of the Court: Rejeana – Marc Vecchio explained what the event is – Sr/Jr boys play on teams in bracket play and then the winning boys' team plays the varsity girls volleyball team. Thursday, February 25, 2010 at 6pm in the LCHS gym. Need concession donations. Kelly Hamlin mentioned that the Copperfield Chick-fil-a would like to donate food for the event. Money raised will come from ticket sales, t-shirt sales, concessions sales, and team registration fees. Packets for team sign up will go out on Monday.
- Casino Night: Katie Adami – Tickets are on sale now. Some were sold at Mr. Lobo. The goal is to sell about 200 tickets. Please take at least 10 tickets to sell. Any that aren't sold should be returned to Stacy Redmond. Still looking for table sponsors at \$250 each. Each table sponsor will get their business name posted at a table and 2 free tickets. We have 18 tables. We are still in need of donations for silent auction and raffle items. Gave out a list of needed items. Also in need of alcohol donations for the cash bar. Will email a list of preferred items. Food has been donated by Black Jack's Restaurant. Need more volunteers for the night of. Future Casino Night meetings will be announced via email. Please promote event to your friends, family, co-workers, etc.
- Fireworks: Rejeana and Andrea – Project Prom had limited participation. ROTC really stepped up to fill the openings. Sales are still being reconciled among the different groups.
- Spring Event: Rejeana – Awaiting approval from school for a "Women's Olympics" which will be a "Komawannaplaya" type events for senior girls. Projected date is March 27, 2010. Please see Toni if you'd like to help.

- Mr. Lobo: Rejeana thanked everyone for helping/participating. Debbie was unable to make the meeting tonight. Calendars are still for sale at \$10 each.

New Fundraiser Opportunities:

- A “Busy Parent” letter is going to be bulk mailed to all senior parents. Donate \$25 for Lobo bucks for their senior.
- Gourmet chocolates: Chocolates by Avan. \$12 each, 25% of sales will go to Project Prom. Gave out flyers and order forms. Need volunteer(s) to coordinate/wrap orders so Avan can concentrate on making them. Pre-orders and money are due by February 28th and delivery (at LCHS) will be late May. Make note on order form if you would like to “special order” for another school.
- Talked about possibly doing candy bags by Avan at \$6 each and selling them on the PP website, at school and at meetings.
- Lydia Morgan spoke about how to “just ask” businesses for donations. She said that if you don’t want to ask, just give her the information and she’ll ask. She has secured donations from Balfour, Gallery Furniture, and a flooring company by “just asking”.

Theme:

- Rejeana – gave hand out with all the different committees for the night of project prom. Explained what each one entailed. Asked that everyone sign up to be either a chair person or a volunteer for a committee. If you chair a committee for that night you get \$5000 extra in Lobo bucks. If you volunteer for a committee for that night you get \$2000 extra in Lobo Bucks.
- Discussed t-shirt ideas and discussed naming each of the different areas with theme type names.
- Areas we would like to have that night are DJ (secured already), hypnotist (secured already), casino tables (secured already), 3 caricature artists, Velcro wall, mechanical bull, bungee run, airbrush tattoos, rock wall, obstacle course.
- We can decorate upstairs Thursday night and/or Friday morning. The main central area can be started at about 7pm (inflatables area) and the rest can be done after 10pm. We hope to be done decorating soon after 10pm.
- All students will be required to ride the buses that will be provided or they will not be allowed to enter the event. They must ride the bus to and from the event. Each bus will have parents on them. Be thinking of fun ideas to do on the bus like games, prizes, lobo bucks, etc.
