

Project Prom 2010 General Meeting
November 16, 2009

Meeting called to order at 7:05. 42 people in attendance. Meeting held at Langham Creek High School room 1903.

Welcome and introductions:

- Andrea Goodhart welcomed everyone and introduced the board members in attendance.
- Andrea reminded everyone to sign in at each meeting and also enter the door prize drawing for extra Lobo Bucks.
- Andrea asked that if anyone wasn't getting their emails to see Bernadette to make sure she has their correct information. Also they need to make sure they have filled out the volunteer form.
- Committee sign up forms are in the back of the room. Be sure to sign up for committees before you leave.

September general meeting minutes:

- Andrea proposed to accept the minutes from the last general meeting. Debbie McKinney motioned, Paula Lennig seconded, passed and minutes accepted.

Treasurer:

- Stacy Redmond reported: \$4800 in golf tournament expenses, \$21,418 net golf tournament income, \$6500 income from Halloween store. Balance is at \$39,000 net - \$2000 of which came from project prom 2009.

Website:

- Lynn Kennedy and Jessica Nance reminded everyone to check the site often for information changes.

Fundraisers:

- Golf Tournament: Rejeana Barnes – 29 teams participated. Net income from silent auction \$3,520, live auction \$4,268, mulligans \$815, the rest came from hole sponsors. Net golf ~\$21,000. Special thank you to Raynell, Kelly, and Sheila for the baskets. They did a great job. Thank you to Andrea. Thank you to Rejeana and John Barnes for Willie's donations.
- Cow Plop: Rejeana – event rescheduled to December 2nd. Need to sell the remaining cow plops. Asked for ideas of where else to sell them.
- King of the Court: Rejeana – asked for someone to step up to help co-chair the event. Mark Vecchio will co-chair. Event needs concessions and advertisement coordinators. Event is Thursday, February 25, 2010.
- Paw Prints: Rejeana – This event is completed. No more paw print requests will be taken. All paw prints have been painted. 128 paw prints were sold. All supplies were donated so everything was profit. ~\$1500 was made.

- Casino Night: Katie Adami – DJ, casino vendor, and Bartender have been secured. Theme is “Las Vegas”. Committee meeting after tonight’s general meeting.
- Fireworks: Rejeana and Andrea – Top Dog has given LCHS Project Prom the store on FM529 between Barker Cypress and Fry Rd. The store is fully “manned” and operated by us - the volunteers. Store dates are December 20th – January 1st. We are opening the fundraiser up to other LCHS clubs and organizations due to the challenge of getting enough project prom volunteers to work it. Project Prom will get priority and a large cut of the profit since we are the organizers. Mr. Silvie is meeting on Monday, November 23rd with club and organization sponsors to see if they are interested in participating. Overall, we will need 1035 people to volunteer to fill all the spots. The busiest days that make the most money are December 30th and 31st. We will need people to volunteer to be “managers” to reconcile the registers and make deposits. Asked everyone to please check their calendars NOW to see when they will be able to volunteer for shifts. There will be a training with Top Dog at their facility for an overview of how things are done on December 5th. Not everyone needs to go. They donating 8% to the organization the first year they participate and then it increases by 1% each consecutive year after that. Kids 16 and older are allowed to work at the fireworks stands.
- Halloween Store: Andrea – We appreciated everyone’s efforts. We had 160 volunteers (students and parents) over the time period. We are still waiting on volunteer time sheets to be given to us by Top Dog. Everyone’s extra 500 Lobo Bucks will be added to their totals who recruited another family member to help.
- Spring Event: Rejeana - Per Dr. Johns, no powder puff game and no dodge ball game. Dr. Johns is upholding Mr. Strother’s decision from a couple of years ago concerning powder puff and per district policy dodge ball is not allowed. Asked for other suggestions. Some suggestions were talent show, battle of the bands, softball tournament and kickball.
- Mr. Lobo: Debbie Starling – The program, logo/posters are done, t-shirts are in process, and calendars are ready. Need a contact at Hobby Lobby or Michaels for 24 silk long stem roses. Would like to have them donated if possible. New judges have been picked this year. So far Miss TX USA and Page Parks - from a modeling agency, have been secured. Need one more. Would like to get a radio personality if possible. Does anyone know of anybody? Tickets are on sale now. Tickets will be sold at lunches starting December 15th. Reserved tickets must be paid for by December 15th.
- Astros Day: Even finished.
- Mums: Event finished.

Theme:

- Rejeana – asked for everyone to think about a catch phrase for the theme and email the board with their ideas.
- Lanyards could look like iPhones and the different event areas such as food, movies, map, etc., could look like applications.
- Gave everyone a packet of event layout. We need to name the areas in relation to the theme. Discussed the map.

- Sign up sheets will be available at the December meeting for the different areas at the event. Please be ready to sign up then.
- We can decorate upstairs Friday morning. The main central area can be started at about 7pm (inflatable area) and the rest can be done after 10pm. We hope to be done decorating soon after 10pm.
- All students will be required to ride the buses that will be provided or they will not be allowed to enter the event. They must ride the bus to and from the event. Each bus will have parents on them. Be thinking of fun ideas to do on the bus like games, prizes, lobo bucks, etc.
- Board will email a list of jobs and committees for the night of the event to everyone before the December general meeting.
- The ~cost from Funplex for the venue is \$30 per student and \$9 per student for food.
- The school would like for every child (LCHS senior) to leave with something.
- We need to leave next year's project prom with at least \$1,000. We got \$2,000.
- We need many items donated for the raffles such as iPods, gift cards, etc.
- The students will be charged \$10 for Project Prom tickets. Each senior will need to purchase a ticket for themselves and one for their date. The ticket cost also includes their project prom t-shirt.
- You don't have to attend prom to be able to go to Project Prom.
- Prizes go only to the seniors.
